Addendum No. 1

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for CONSTRUCTION ON STATE HIGHWAY IN FRESNO COUNTY IN FRESNO FROM 0.3 MILE NORTH OF BULLARD AVENUE OVERCROSSING TO HERNDON AVENUE UNDERCROSSING.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on Tuesday, March 9, 2010.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Bidders and Special Provisions, the Bid book, the Federal Minimum Wages with Modification Number 49 dated 02/19/10, and provide an additional copy of the Information Handout.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.10, "SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION," the table in the first paragraph is revised as follows:

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In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.27, "EARTHWORK," the last sentence in the third paragraph is revised as follows:

"Full compensation for cutting the existing surfacing shall be considered as included in the contract price paid per cubic yard for roadway excavation and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.295, "RETAINING WALL EARTHWORK," is added as attached.

In the Amendments to the Standard Specifications Dated May 2006, Section 2-1.12, "BID DOCUMENT COMPLETION," subsection 2-1.12A, "General," is revised as follows:

"2-1.12A General

Complete forms in the Bid book.

On the Subcontractor List you may either submit each subcontracted bid item number and corresponding percentage with your bid or fax this information to (916) 227-6282 within 24 hours after bid opening. If you fail to submit this information within the time specified, your bid is nonresponsive.

Except for the bid item number and the percentage of each item subcontracted, do not fax submittals."

In the Bid book, the "SUBCONTRACTOR LIST" form is revised as attached.

To Bid book holders:

Inquiries or questions in regard to this addendum must be communicated as a bidder inquiry and must be made as noted in the Notice to Bidders section of the Notice to Bidders and Special Provisions.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the Bid book.

Submit bids in the Bid book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.

10-1.295 RETAINING WALL EARTHWORK

Retaining wall earthwork shall conform to the provisions in Section 19, "Earthwork," of the Standard Specifications and these special provisions.

The Contractor shall submit to the Engineer working drawings and construction sequence for their proposed method of retaining wall construction for the site. Attention is directed to Section 5-1.02, "Plans and Working Drawings." The drawings shall be signed by an engineer who is registered as a Civil Engineer in the State of California. One set of the drawings and one copy of the design calculations shall be furnished to the Engineer. The Contractor shall allow three weeks after complete drawings and all support data are submitted for the review of their proposed method of retaining wall construction.

Working drawings for retaining wall earthwork shall contain all information required for the construction and quality control of the earthwork, including the following:

1. The proposed schedule and detailed construction sequence. Construction sequence shall include measures to ensure wall and slope stability.
2. Methods of excavation to the staged lifts indicated and excavation equipment types.
3. Temporary shoring plans.

Should the Engineer fail to complete the review within 2 weeks and if, in the opinion of the Engineer, the Contractor's controlling operation is delayed or interfered with by reason of the delay in working drawings and construction sequence plan review for the retaining wall, the delay will be considered a right of way delay as specified in Section 8-1.09, "Right of Way Delays. "

MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Measurement and payment for structure excavation (retaining wall) shall conform to the provisions in Sections 19-3.08, "Measurement," and 19-3.09, "Payment," of the Standard Specifications and these special provisions.

Full compensation for working drawings and supplements, and shoring, if required, for retaining wall construction shall be considered as included in the contract price paid per cubic yard for structure excavation (retaining wall) and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

The bidder must identify each subcontractor performing work in an amount in excess of 1/2 of 1 percent of the total bid or \$10,000, whichever is greater (Pub Cont Code § 4100 et seq.). Complete columns 1 and 4 and submit with the bid. Complete columns 2 and 3 and submit with the bid or fax to (916) 227-6282 within 24 hours after the bid opening. Failure to provide complete information in columns 1 through 4 within the time specified will result in a non-responsive bid.
